Bassetlaw Integrated care Partnership: Board Summary, April 2019

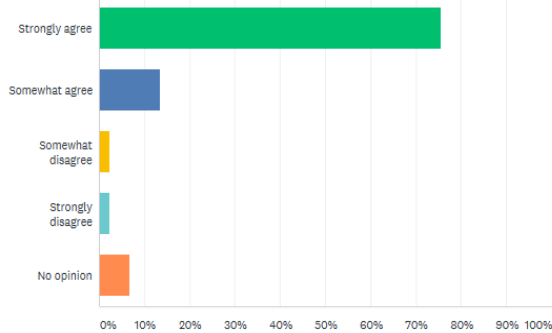
In addition to a highlight report on all work streams of the Integrated Care Partnership (ICP), the Board received a presentation from the **Transport Work Stream**. Progress following community engagement in Mathersey Thorpe and Tuxford includes changes to bus routes so patients can access Tuxford Medical Centre on public transport. The presentation is available at:

The Board received the first populated **outcomes framework** for the ICP, and have identified priority areas for focus over coming months. The first priority is **childhood obesity**, as 11.8% of children in reception, and 22.9% in year 6 are obese – higher than the national average. There will be a report, presentation and action-oriented discussion at the June meeting.

The Board requested that views of stakeholders on a potential **Bassetlaw position on vaping** on public sites. The results of the engagement were shared with the Board, who requested that a draft position statement for organisations be prepared. The results are available here:

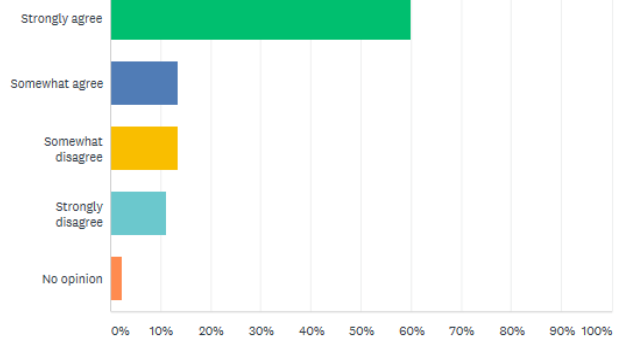
Agree a consistent, Bassetlaw-wide position on vaping/ use of e-cigarettes
