Bassetlaw Integrated care Partnership: Board Summary, June 2019

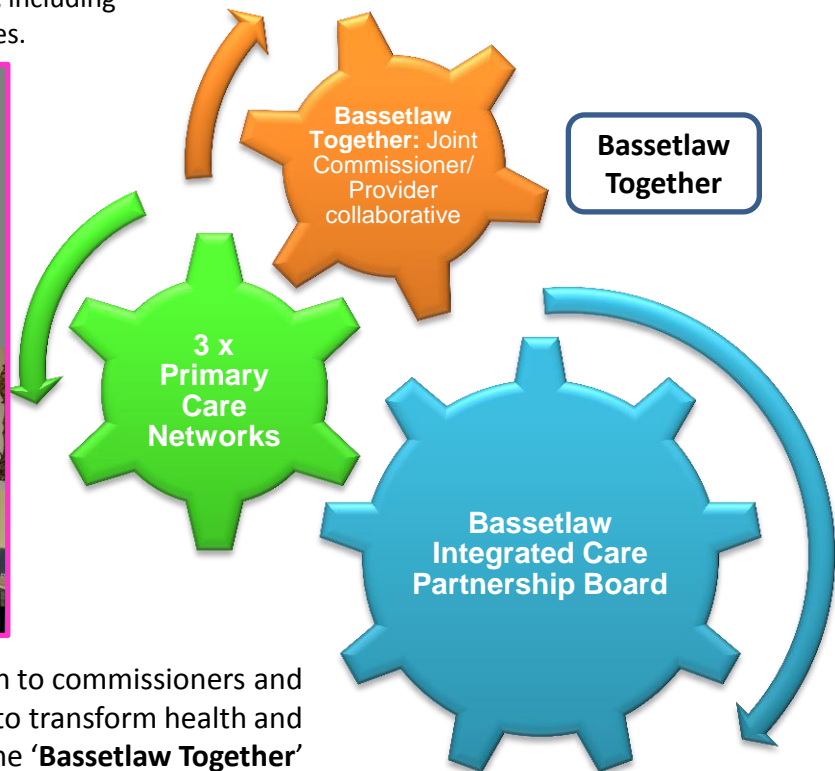
The Board received a **highlight report** summarising progress in 2017/18. Key deliverables for the year included:

- Better connected children and young people's services – inventory of health and wellbeing services published and downloaded hundreds of times, a more holistic approach to wellbeing, and increase in referrals of children to emotional wellbeing support;
- Workforce events with schools - more young people taking health and care GCSE option;
- Interoperability on Bassetlaw Hospital site went live, so staff can view social care records;
- Community engagement enabled new bus routes to primary care venues to reduce home visits and reduce isolation, and joint transport bids submitted;
- Joint outcomes framework developed, including broader population wellbeing measures.



A vaping advice poster was approved by the Board, and may now be used by local partners.

A presentation from public health information the Board's discussions about childhood obesity. Partners agreed to a 'call to action' on the subject, to develop a local plan.



The Board approved a new approach to commissioners and providers working together to transform health and wellbeing services through the '**Bassetlaw Together**' partnership, as the 'engine room' of the ICP
