Bassetlaw Integrated Care Partnership (ICP) Board Summary – February 2020

The Board meeting was hosted **Larwood Health Partnerships**. This was the first meeting of its kind, with the ICP Board welcoming colleagues from Mid Nottinghamshire ICP to the meeting, which provided the chance for both areas to learn from each others approaches, and identify opportunities to work together. Colleagues from Bassetlaw ICP will attend a Mid Notts ICP Board meeting in the spring to continue the shared learning and co-operation.



The **Bassetlaw Prevention Strategy** was approved, which provides a focus on weight management, reducing harm from alcohol, improving physical activity levels, housing and employment. Thanks were offered from the Board to Steve Brown, Bassetlaw District Council and Karen Whitlam, Bassetlaw Citizens Advice, for leading the health citizenship work stream which owns the strategy.

The Board also examined the latest version of the ICP's **outcomes framework**, as well as public health data, to track progress and identify future priorities. It was agreed that a future Board meeting would have a deep dive into violent crime data.

CGL (Change, Grow, Live) were welcomed to the meeting, and presented their plans for new **substance misuse services**, commissioned by Nottinghamshire County Council public health division, commencing in April 2020.

The new service will include a new tele-triage function, a greater emphasis on alcohol, and a chatbot online. Support for children of substance misusing parents is now part of the contract, and support for families and carers will be provided by Hetty's.
